To make this come to life, we need your generosity. I invite you to secure one of the RCH150 Anniversary Art





What is Me and UooUoo?

In 2020, The Royal Children's Hospital (RCH) Melbourne will turn 150 years young. To celebrate this incredible milestone of great care, the RCH Foundation, supported by Wild in Art, is bringing colour and creativity to the streets of Melbourne and Geelong with a spectacular public art trail and fundraising auction.

Me and UooUoo will combine Victoria's renowned passion for the arts and culture with a dash of outdoor adventure, encouraging individuals, families and businesses to get moving and contribute to the enduring legacy of the RCH for future generations.

UooUoo (pronounced you-you) has been created by award-winning Melbourne artist Alexander Knox, who also created the iconic sculpture 'Creature' that stands in the RCH main foyer. UooUoo's shape is loosely drawn from Australian animals the wombat and dugong.

Join UooUoo on a colourful outdoor adventure to help change the future of paediatric healthcare for generations to come.

How Me and UooUoo works



In December 2019, a public call out for artists will commence through an online submission portal.

UooUoo will become a canvas for creativity as artists will be invited to customise a 1.5 metre-tall sculpture. These designs will be presented to sponsors who will select their own unique UooUoo.

The 100 individually decorated UooUoos will then find homes in laneways, streets, parks and public spaces, forming two sections of a

walking trail across Melbourne and Geelong.

When the art trail finishes, Melbourne and Geelong will hold special farewell weekend events across both cities. Finally, the sculptures will be auctioned at these exclusive events and take up permanent residence with their new owners.

By sponsoring or purchasing the sculptures, individuals and corporations will contribute to this major fundraising event for the hospital, ensuring the enduring legacy of great care for future generations.


